



This practical course provides participants with the knowledge and skills necessary to implement an Artificial Intelligence Management System (AIMS) based on the ISO 42001 standard. Through interactive sessions, discussions, and practical exercises, participants will learn how to establish, implement, maintain, and continually improve an AIMS within their organization. This course is designed for individuals who will be directly involved in the implementation and management of AI systems according to ISO 42001.

Upon completion of this course, participants will be able to:

- Understand the detailed requirements of ISO 42001.
- Plan and scope the implementation of an AIMS within their organization.
- Establish the context of the organization in relation to AI and identify relevant stakeholders.
- Define AI policies, objectives, and processes aligned with ISO 42001.
- Conduct AI risk assessments and implement appropriate risk treatment measures.
- Develop necessary documentation for the AIMS.
- Implement controls related to data management, AI development lifecycle, and validation.
- Establish processes for monitoring, measurement, analysis, and evaluation of the AIMS.
- Implement processes for addressing nonconformities and achieving continual improvement.
- Understand the requirements for internal audits of the AIMS.
